

### **DECEMBER WORSHIP NOTES**



Advent (the beginning of the Christian calendar year) starts Sunday, Nov. 29th. This is "the year of Luke", or Lectionary C, which means the readings this year will focus on Luke's version of the gospel. Luke's gospel uses Mark's gospel as one of its primary resources. The first two chapters of Luke provide an introduction to the entire gospel as a story of the fulfillment of God's promises. They contain much of the familiar scripture used to tell the Christmas story, including Mary's Song and the Magnificat.

The term salvation and its synonyms are used more in Luke than any other gospel.

Jesus' divine hospitality and inclusivity is exhibited as he reaches to the outermost margins of society. Jesus is often seen going to a meal, sitting down at a meal, or leaving a meal.

To understand Luke more completely, consider reading a commentary. I intend to rely on my old standby, Barclay's *Gospel of Luke: New Daily Study Bible* series.

Worship this month features a modified "Holden Evening Prayer" liturgy and plenty of Christmas carols. A special treat on Dec. 13th will be the Kids' Christmas Worship service, a youth-led worship featuring the talents of our young folks. On Christmas Eve, there will be two worship services, which share the Christmas Story told through the readings of Luke and Isaiah with Christmas carols in the traditional candlelight setting. Also, there will be Christmas Day worship service. Guest preacher will be LPA Rick Brown. December 27th will be an entire service of beloved Christmas carols. ~Celeste
