

Pausing at the Station(s)

I've been thinking about "stations" lately. The station I visit most often sells gas. I stop there to refuel one tank and empty another. On long trips, we stretch and scrounge food and drink. With kids and dogs along, gas stations and rest stops are recreational, too.

The Stations of the Cross in Jerusalem are established sites where pilgrims to Jerusalem pause and remember the events of Jesus' last hours, his walk on the *Via Dolorosa*, the Way of Sorrow. Last month during Holy Week, Faith's worshipers paused at Stations of the Cross colored by our people to refuel on the self-giving love of God demonstrated in Jesus' Passion. service, Carol exclaimed: "I just can't imagine that he'd go through all that for us!" Me neither. Wow.

Faith's Stations of the Cross will remain on display in our sanctuary throughout the Easter Season (the month of May). When you're here, do take a moment to fuel up on God's love and the creativity of our friends expressed on our walls. Drink in the colors. Reflect on the words. Stand back and comprehend the images. If you're an artist, please sign your work!

Maybe wonder about the "stations" in *your* life. What are ways or places where you stop to refuel? Are you getting enough of them? Our daughter Hannah was featured in PLU's school paper last week under the headline: "No Sleep? No Problem!" She called that night to assure us that "no sleep" was indeed a problem and that she'd be getting more of it this week. ③



Do you have excuses to tell the stories to your kids or to friends in need of encouragement? As I hung our Stations, I remembered making banners to honor my quilting Grandma's death date, Good Friday. They were for Easter, all white and gold and strong and bright. A station I remembered with a smile.

Gas stations aren't the only places we stop to refuel and refresh. I hope! Please give yourself permission in the crazy whirl of spring to take (and I mean *take*) sweet stationary time with God and others on ballfields and gardens, on trails and sunny porches, on the road and safe at home, in scripture, silence, and prayer. *~Pastor Brenda*



2.5 hours of Continuing Education credits are available for a wide range of professions.



March Council Highlights

Jennifer Murillo was welcomed to the Council as the new Steward of Outreach. Discussion continued concerning weather to continue leasing a copier, or to purchase a LaserJet copier for office needs.



The General Fund Reserve now holds over \$20,000, up from \$13,000 at the beginning of 2016. Due to recent emergency expenditures the General Fund and Building and Grounds Savings accounts have been negatively affected. A get well plan was approved to help replenish

those accounts. \$4,000 from the Scandinavian Dinner account will be invested in a Thrivent Account with

another \$977 transferred to the Building and Grounds Savings account to help replenish that account.

The new tenants of Faith House were married last month and have moved into the rental.

2017 Balance Sheet: The Good News!

Our congregation, like most congregations nationwide, struggles yearly with their operating budget. Predicting income is a challenge. But we have another side to our financial picture that we have every reason to be proud of and rejoice in – our Balance Sheet is rock solid.


Thanks to the wisdom and generosity of our past leadership and congregations, we enter the 2nd Quarter of 2017 with the following Balance Sheet:

- \$987.800 1. Total Assets:
- 2. Total Liabilities: \$ 3,400 (our liabilities are Federal and State taxes)
- 3. Total Equity: \$984,400

Faith Lutheran is debt free. Faith owns the Church building, Faith House (the rental property next door), has Current Assets (bank accounts) of \$95,500 and Other Assets (Thrivent, Endowments, etc.) of \$169,200.

We need to pause and celebrate these blessings and to thank our past leadership and congregations for their wisdom, generosity and strength!
