CARING CONVERSATIONS



Discuss in your home or small group:

- Talk about a time when you felt sad and discouraged.
- Jesus responds to the sadness of Mary and Martha with the promise of the resurrection that began for them that very day. How does your Christian life make a difference for you today?
- Where do you see resurrection life happening?

DEVOTIONS



Read: Romans 8:6-11.

Paul contrasts the "mind of the flesh" with the "mind of the Spirit." The one leads to death, and the other leads to life and peace. To have the wrong attitude or the wrong mindset in life, one that is not guided by God's power of love and forgiveness, is to have the "mind of the flesh." It is a life that is a dead end. Life in the Spirit is directed by the power of Christ's resurrection and shapes our lives now and into God's eternity. Reflect on how life in the kingdom of God is different from all other ways of living. Conclude by praying Psalm 130 and then the Lord's Prayer.

SERVICE



To have the "mind of the Spirit" is to have a mind shaped by Jesus, the one who came to serve and who calls all his followers to be servants. Create a list of the ways you would like to use your God-given gifts to serve others and creation. Then create a log that notes the ways you are able to use your gifts as a servant of God's love. Service to others can be as simple as offering intercessory prayers as well as a smile and a helping hand.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS



Death happens. It is a reality that we often avoid discussing. The church is a community of faith that reaches out to others with care, support, and the hope of resurrection. Think about an individual or family that is grieving the death of a loved one. Plan a visit or send them a sympathy card. Whether it is a visit or a card, consider including words from Psalm 130 and John 11.25-26.
