CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your home or small group:

- Tell about a time you supported a cause or a person who needed help.
- Sometimes following Jesus involves difficulty or suffering. In what ways have you experienced this?
- Jesus says, "If you want to save your life, you will destroy it. But if you want to give up your live for me, you will find it" (Matthews 16:25). What do you think Jesus means by this?

Reflect on Paul's list of virtues for Christians, then make posters illustrating all the things these verses encourage Christians to do (e.g., love others, honor others, be joyful). Place the posters around your home.

Pick out one of the virtues listed in Romans 12:9-21. With prayerful attention and focus pursue this virtue with the goal of making a positive impact on another person's life this week.
