## A Year of Blessing

When have you been blessed? How did you know?

Doug was blessed when his Prince of Peace and Arlee folks threw him a farewell party, sang him a song, and told him how he had touched their lives. I'm blessed when Doug makes dinner, hugs me, and tells me he loves me. I knew we'd blessed my family when Mom called, tears in her voice, to remember when Aunt Norma asked Doug and I as brand-new pastors to visit her 93-year-old brother Ed and see if he'd be baptized. As long as we didn't need to dunk him in the creek, Ed was willing to trust the promise of God in word and water—and, that very night, to fall asleep in God's promise and awaken on the other side.

Liturgical Christians mark two big blessings in January: Epiphany (January 6) recalls "wise men from the East" blessing the newborn "King of the Jews" and his parents with precious gifts and what must have been a shocking drop-in visit. The Baptism of Our Lord blesses the adult Jesus rising from the Jordan River with the sound of skies tearing, a dove-like Spirit descending, and a voice declaring: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I'm thoroughly delighted." (Mark & Matthew)

We are blessed when 1) Someone SEES us, takes real notice of who we are. 2) Someone SPEAKS WELL of us: Imagine the God's voice declaring love and delight in YOU! And 3) Someone GIVES of their own life that we might receive. Doug's farewell party at the Sons of Norway Hall took time and effort. Gifts hauled from Iraq to Palestine on camel-back, horseback, or afoot were precious, indeed.

**Faith is a community of blessing.** The members and friends of this "family of God built on love" work hard to SEE each other, SPEAK WELL of each other at all times, and GIVE of our own lives to build up others. We do these things because God blesses us first: God SEES you as worthy of love and gifted to serve; God SPEAKS affirmation to you in scripture, prayer, and community; God GIVES all you need to survive, and the life and death of Jesus to love and lead you into real Life that endures.

**Blessing is too rare.** Always. How could there ever be enough? A wise teacher writes, "We can't force others to bless us, but we can bless others...[and when we do] it will not be long afterward that our hearts will feel an exuberance that will, all on its own, say: *God, it feels good to be alive!* When we act like God, we get to feel like God And God is never depressed" (Rolheiser, *Sacred Fire*, p. 237).

**So God, I'm bold to ask** that you pour out your blessings on me and my friends at Faith. Let us receive your attention, your affirmations, and your gifts deeply and with thanks! Fill us so full with your love that we overflow acting like you, feeling like you, blessing like you.

And friends, let's make this a "year of blessing" at Faith—I think that sounds AWESOME! Happy New Year! *Pastor Brenda*

## **December Leadership Highlights**


The 2018 Budget was unanimously approved at the December 10th Special Meeting. Thanks to all that could attend for the great discussion and productive Q&A session!

## Input Requested by Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp

The Board of Directors of Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp has proposed a change to the camp's by-laws that would allow two new opportunities: 1) Congregations not affiliated with the ELCA could apply to become members of the FLBC Corporation responsible to send two voting delegates to the Annual Meeting of the Corporation (at which new Board Members are elected & the budget approved, etc.). 2) The Board of Directors would add two At-Large Director seats for folks who may or may not be affiliated with Corporate member congregations.

In recent years, several non-ELCA congregations have expressed interest in becoming members of the FLBC Corporation. Lutheran Outdoor Ministry, like our congregations and communities, is growing in diversity. The board and staff are hopeful that giving voice to those who share our vision from different perspectives will deepen and strengthen our ministry and organization.

The camp requests our input via a formal response form by January 19. If you have comments or questions to share, or if you'd like more information, Pastor Brenda has the official documents (which she's GLAD to share) and the response form Faith is encouraged to submit. Please contact her as soon as possible.

#### **Details of the changes:**

- Application process: Congregations wishing to join the Corporation would send a written request to the FLBC Board of directors along with a signed commitment to affirm and uphold FLBC core values.
   After review by the FLBC Executive Committee, applications will be forwarded to the spring meeting of the full Board for approval. Approved congregations would be invited to the Annual Mtg.
- All member congregations will be invited to send two lay delegates and one rostered leader as voting members. Current practice is to allow more delegates to larger congregations. This change simplifies the process.
- At-Large Board Members will be recommended for election by the Nominating Committee from among individuals who share FLBC's Mission and Values. They will seek candidates with specific skills not currently represented by sitting board members.



Should these changes be supported by FLBC's consituent congregations, the process for approving them will begin at the Annual Meeting in the fall of 2018. The FLBC Board of Directors is convinced that these changes will strengthen the camp's ministry, and equally concerned that any proposed change in our by-laws must be enacted only with the strong support of the corporation.
