# **Council Highlights, March 2019**

### **Summary of Significant Actions:**

✓ Kerry moved, LaDonna seconded, and motion passed, that twelve round tables with a storage cart be purchased for the fellowship hall (\$1,899.99 at Costco). under the property and grounds budget. The Scandinavian Dinner account will transfer the amount to property and grounds.

- ✓ Susan moved, LaDonna seconded, motion passed, that \$1,000.00 offering be made to the Synod House from the Scandinavian Dinner. Per the By-Laws, a 10% tithe will be given to the FLC general reserve fund.
- ✓ Marlin moved, Susan seconded, and motion passed to approve all of the steward reports as presented.
- ✓ Motion: Marlin moved, Kerry seconded, motion passed to appoint Jeff Montgomery as Fellowship Steward.
- ✓ Motion: Dean Moved, LaDonna seconded, motion passed to authorize the Stewards to expense up to \$300 to their respective budget line items that support Gerloff Youth & Music expenditures without reporting to or asking for the approval of The Endowment Committee or Church Council.

### Thank you to Jeff Montgomery for stepping up to be our Hospitality and Fellowship Steward!

### The Scandinavian Dinner numbers have been crunched!

- We served approximately 340 dinners on site plus had about 20 meals to go and delivered to our homebound.
- We took in \$7665 in ticket and leftover sales, plus another \$750 in Thrivent Grants (thanks Thrivent!) Our expenses totaled \$3813.
- Proceeds will be used to purchase 12 new round tables for the fellowship room (\$1900), and we will send \$1000 to the Montana Synod House.
- We will also tithe 10% to the Faith Lutheran General Fund Reserve Fund. That leaves us plenty of seed money for the next dinner.

# Giving Status through March 24<sup>th</sup> 2019

FLC received \$29,433 in General Fund Giving through March 24<sup>th</sup>. This is \$8,099 below our 2019 requirements.

For the month of March, through the 24<sup>th</sup> we received \$11,341. This is \$952 more than expected.
