

FLC Council Minutes July 20, 2018

At last month's meeting, council voted to terminate free mailing of the Faith Herald and to establish a subscription basis for its mailing, commencing with the September issue. The next issue is a summer July-August issue.

Change in Herald Distribution Coming with September 2018 Issue

If you wish to have the Herald mailed to you, we have established a subscription service that will be become effective with the September 2018 issue - the July-August 2018 issue is the last we will mail without a subscription.

Otherwise, the Herald is available via email, through the FLC website, or if you prefer a hard copy, it will be placed in your distribution box at church.

Annual subscription rate is \$15.00, which covers costs of mailing preparation and postage. If you wish to subscribe, please send a check for that amount to the office Attn: Faith Lutheran Church Herald, 171 Lewis Lane, Hamilton MT 59840, and include the mailing address you prefer, or simply cut out the address from a previously mailed Herald.

If you wish to still have the Herald mailed to you but have a financial hardship regarding subscription cost, please contact the office. We will consider all such requests in complete confidentiality.

Other Significant Actions:

Council's general agenda for the rest of 2018 will focus on these three critical issues: Call Process, ELCA Mandated Constitution Revision, FLC Strategic Planning.

Constitution Revision Schedule Established: Draft available for discussion at the July 18, 2018 meeting; Final draft completed for review at August council meeting; submit to MT synod for review and approval during first week of September; ideally, and with possible iteration to address issues identified, MT synod will approve in time to submit to congregation at the February 2019 congregation meeting.

Strategic planning process targeted for completion by the end of 2018. Call Committee update summary: they have all required references; have commenced operation June 13; Troy Hanson elected leader.

Tabled Items

Faith House issue decision deferred until July council meeting. MT synod house levy (\$1K/year for 25 years) decision deferred to July meeting.
