This message was sent by Tanya Amador on May 11th. Tanya's husband, Nelson, grew up in Nicaragua and with Tanya's help created the mission. This is the mission the group from Faith Lutheran helped with in 2014.

Dear Friends of Corner of Love,

Earlier this week, over one million Nicaraguans marched for FREEDOM.

Throughout the country, citizens are gathering almost daily to demand a new government. With such widespread civil unrest. Corner of Love had to postpone all summer 2018

With such widespread civil unrest, Corner of Love had to postpone all summer 2018 mission trips. We will not host teams if we cannot assure their safety. There are road blockades on almost all major highways and roads right now. These and other disturbances would cause us lengthy delays in transporting our groups. We believe it best to ask our mission teams for these summer months to serve with us at a later date, once all this has subsided.

This decision greatly affects our operations. Will you help us keep serving impoverished Nicaraguans and tackle the \$110,000 lost from cancelled teams?

#### FLC Council Establishes the Doris Koch Memorial Fund From your Steward of Finance: *Dean Drake*

#### I have wonderful news to report to you this month!

The FLC Council voted unanimously at its May meeting to establish the Doris Koch Memorial Endowment to honor the memory of a great

lady that has given so much to support this congregation. Doris has provided help to many FLC ministries in the past and recently gifted \$200,000 to Faith from her estate. This gift was given without strings.

The Doris Koch Memorial Endowment has been funded at \$100,000 and will be invested with Thrivent and managed by our FLC Endowment Committee currently chaired by John Trangmoe.

The return received from this Endowment's Thrivent investment will be available to the Endowment Committee to help fund the needs of FLC and its ministries. The principal will always remain intact unless there is a dire emergency that would require its use. In the event of a dire emergency, Council, working with the Endowment Committee, will either be able to borrow from it or reduce the funding level and withdraw the difference.

Based upon an expected return of ~5%, this will provide ~\$5,000 per year, every year, to the Endowment Committee to help fund needy projects at Faith!

This Endowment honors the memory of Doris Koch both for this and future generations. We will steward it well. *Dean Drake*
