Do you or anyone you know have bicycles you no longer use hanging in your garage, out in your shed, or in the backyard?

We refurbish and recycle bicycles in the following ways:

1. We rebuild them for use by young people for our group rides.

2. We pair a young person with a mentor and together they disassemble and rebuild the bike. We give the young person a helmet and lock and they have a bike of their own to ride.

3. Our mechanics rebuild bikes for resale in our Community Bike Shop Recyclery to help provide funding for our ministries.

We will have a trailer at the Synod Assembly. So, if you would like to help us out, send your unneeded bicycles to the Assembly with Darrin Heitmann or Celeste Pogachar, and we will haul them back to our shop.
