COMING SOON, A NEW BISHOP!

I recently represented our congregation at the 2018 Bishop's Convocation in Helena. At this fall gathering of Lutheran leaders from across the state we began the process of discerning a new bishop for the Montana Synod of the ELCA. A new bishop will be chosen at the Synod Assembly next June, and will be installed on September 21, 2019.

The process of selecting a new bishop resembles the call process more than it does an election. The synod council is responsible for guiding us through this process using an Ecclesiastical Ballot, which means there are no predetermined candidates— a blank slate so to speak. After the first round of balloting, the top seven names are voted upon, and the list is narrowed down in subsequent rounds until there is just one name remaining. There have been only 4 bishops in the past 31 years in the Montana Synod. Chances are, the new bishop will serve 12 years (2 consecutive terms), so this is not a decision to be taken lightly.


What is the job description for a Lutheran bishop? The bishop's office is a teaching office, setting the tone for our common mission. Our current bishop, Jessica Crist, has served us well during her 12 year tenure. She has logged literally thousands of miles traveling to every corner of this big state to keep our faith communities connected. She has done an amazing job of shepherding us through some very trying times (including fallout from the social statement on human sexuality), as well as celebrations (like the common worship celebration with Catholics for the 500th anniversary of the Reformation), and everything "ordinary" in between.

So who or what is the Montana Synod? Well, we are! It is not just those folks in Chicago; it is not just those folks in Great Falls. We are unique among religious organizations in that our bishop is not appointed; he or she does not come from thousands of miles away. The new bishop will rise from our ranks. Chances are, last Friday, I was in sitting in the same room as our future bishop.

Now we here at Faith need to pray for this process. We need to ask the Holy Spirit to work in the hearts and minds of those who would feel the call to serve in this very important work of our church. We also need to pray for those who are going to assist our new bishop. In upcoming months, the synod council will ask our congregation for input, and yes, they truly want to hear from us! *Celeste Pogachar*

Summary of Significant Actions October 17, 2018 Council meeting

- Pastor Mick has requested leave for Sundays of 11/18 & 11/25. Pulpit supply will be provided by Margie Fiedler on 11/18, and John Lund on 11/25.
- Call Committee recently interviewed four candidates.
- Harvest Dinner Oct 28, 2018
- The date for the Scandinavian Dinner, January 26th, 2019.
- Christmas program will be during Dec. 9th worship this year.
- Motion to approve \$5,000.00 as the annual operating budget for Wednesday Night Alive! fellowship activity for 2019 was approved.
- Motion to approve a 2% across-the-board pay raise for FLC staff approved by vote.
- Motion to approve transfer of \$7.5K from Gerloff Youth & Music Thrivent account to the Gerloff Youth & Music Salary Offset Account approved by vote (extends, by an additional year, the "get well" plan approved previously).
- Support for Synod House Mortgage: By consensus ensuing a related discussion, council decided to eliminate this item from the budget, to not support this request.
