Faith Lutheran Church Approves 2020 Budget

The congregation of Faith Lutheran Church unanimously approved the 2020 Budget at a Special Meeting held December 8th.

Council wishes to thank everyone that participated in this year's budgetary process to include our Mutual Ministry Committee for their input on pay and benefits, our Financial Secretary, Heather Wintergerst, for her work in producing records and financial analysis, and all of the folks from our congregation that participated in the process. We began in September and concluded the workup process on December 1st with a congregational Q&A.

The totals for the 2020 Budget follow:

- Total Expenditures	= \$ 238,148.38
- Total Revenues	= \$ 203,855.48
- Underfunded	= \$ 34,292.90

Our underfunding issue and the root causes are being actively worked by Council with support from congregational teams and individuals. While it is early in the process, we are starting to see results. New members are joining Faith and we sense a renewed vitality and spirit! We are growing again and that is a key component to resolving our underfunding issue. We pray that this trend continues as we move forward.


