Join us for Evening Advent Services with the Holden Evening Prayer.....



December Worship Notes

Advent (the beginning of the Christian calendar year) started Sunday, November 29th. This is "the year of Mark", or Lectionary B, which means we will focus on Mark's version of



the gospel, supplemented by readings from the Gospel of John. Mark is the earliest of the four gospels, believed to have been written around 70 CE, when the temple in Jerusalem was destroyed. Mark is the primary literary source for the gospels of Matthew and Luke, and a strong influence on John. Mark's gospel depicts women as leaders in the ministry of Jesus; exemplars of faith and the values He taught.

Due to the Covid pandemic and our effort to protect all those we care for, worship services this year will be broadcast live on You Tube and our

Facebook page. This includes services on Sundays, Wednesday evenings and Christmas Eve. There will not be a Christmas morning service.

Can You Contribute to Our Virtual Christmas Services?

Just because there will be no in-person worship this Christmas season, that doesn't mean we won't have lovely and meaningful Christmas services! We have a great opportunity to prerecord the music and readings, and Josie VanDenburg has offered to compile and edit our offerings into two services that will available for you to watch on You Tube or Facebook at your convenience (and share with your family and friends).

So here's how it works:

We will use the same bulletin templates we have always used for the December 24th and December 27th worship services. If you wish to have Josie record it, she will be available the week of December 14th for private, socially distanced recording sessions at the church.
