Renew us each day in the light of Christ. Amen.



## God Speaks to Us in the Word

(AM: Please be seated for the readings)

#### **First Reading:**

#### 2 Samuel 7:1-11, 16

# Lector: A reading from the 7<sup>th</sup> Chapter of 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel.

Instead of David building a house (temple) for God, God promises to establish David's house (dynasty) forever. Centuries later, after the Babylonian exile, no king sat on the throne. Even then, however, the people of Israel remembered this promise and continued to hope for a king, the messiah, God's anointed.

<sup>1</sup>Now when the king was settled in his house, and the LORD had given him rest from all his enemies around him, <sup>2</sup>the king said to the prophet Nathan, "See now, I am living in a house of cedar, but the ark of God stays in a tent." <sup>3</sup>Nathan said to the king, "Go, do all that you have in mind; for the LORD is with you."

<sup>4</sup>But that same night the word of the LORD came to Nathan: <sup>5</sup>Go and tell my servant David: Thus says the LORD: Are you the one to build me a house to live in? <sup>6</sup>I have not lived in a house since the day I brought up the people of Israel from Egypt to this day, but I have been moving about in a tent and a tabernacle. <sup>7</sup>Wherever I have moved about among all the people of Israel, did I ever speak a word with any of the tribal leaders of Israel, whom I commanded to shepherd my people Israel, saying, "Why have you not built me a house of cedar?" <sup>8</sup>Now therefore thus you shall say to my servant David: Thus says the LORD of hosts: I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep to be prince over my people Israel; <sup>9</sup>and I have been with you wherever you went, and

have cut off all your enemies from before you; and I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth. <sup>10</sup>And I will appoint a place for my people Israel and will plant them, so that they may live in their own place, and be disturbed no more; and evildoers shall afflict them no more, as formerly, <sup>11</sup>from the time that I appointed judges over my people Israel; and I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover the LORD declares to you that the LORD will make you a house. <sup>16</sup>Your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me; your throne shall be established forever.

#### Psalm 89:1-4, 19-26

from age to age my mouth will proclaim your faithfulness.

  - I have sworn an oath to David my servant:
- <sup>4</sup> 'I will establish your line forever,
  - and preserve your throne for all generations."

<sup>19</sup>You spoke once in a vision and said to your faithful people:

"I have set the crown upon a warrior and have exalted one chosen out of the people.

<sup>20</sup>I have found David my servant;

#### with my holy oil have I anointed him.

<sup>21</sup>My hand will hold him fast

and my arm will make him strong.

- <sup>22</sup>No enemy shall deceive him,
  - nor shall the wicked bring him down.
- <sup>23</sup>I will crush his foes before him and strike down those who hate him.
- <sup>24</sup>My faithfulness and steadfast love are with him,
- and he shall be victorious through my name.
- <sup>25</sup>I will set his hand on the sea,
- and his right hand on the rivers.
- <sup>26</sup>He will say to me, 'You are my father, my God, and the rock of my salvation.'

#### **Second Reading** Lector: A reading from the 16<sup>th</sup> chapter of Romans:

Paul closes his letter to the Romans by praising God because, in the proclamation of the gospel of Jesus Christ, God has revealed the promised, divine plan of salvation for all humanity. Paul proclaims this gospel of Christ in order to bring about the obedience of faith among all nations.

<sup>25</sup>Now to God who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the proclamation of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages <sup>26</sup>but is now disclosed, and through the prophetic writings is made known to all the Gentiles, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith—<sup>27</sup>to the only wise God, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever! Amen.
