The Community Meals Program

First I'd like to share a message from the Family Shelter of the Bitterroot Community Coordinators...

We wanted to thank each team leader and your volunteers for your support during this challenging year (2020). During the months of April - May, we served 5,362 To-Go meals. When we restarted the meals in October, we have served another 2,166 To-Go meals. The need continues to be great as we head into 2021. The Family Shelter will do all it can to provide the food/groceries for teams to use for meal preparation going forward as we serve our community. We appreciate your support and donations are always welcome.

As the Faith Lutheran Community Meals coordinator, I would like to thank everyone who has stepped up in so many ways to help with meals we have served during the past year. This includes donating food items, money, time and helping hands for preparing and serving the meals. We serve on the 4th Tuesday of the month and usually serve 65-90 meals during a regular year. This year we helped serve 150-175 meals a night during the early months of the pandemic and an average of 70 meals this fall.

<u>The next meal that Faith prepares and services will be Tuesday, January 26th.</u> Preparation begins at 10 am in the Faith Lutheran kitchen (all safety precautions are followed). Four volunteers are appreciated at this time. Then the meals are served between 5 and 6:30 pm at the Cornerstone Bible Church on Fairgrounds Rd. It is helpful to have 6-8 volunteers at this time.

Faith Lutheran Church Approves 2021 Budget

The congregation of Faith Lutheran Church unanimously approved the 2021 Budget at a Special Meeting held December 13th.

Council wishes to thank everyone that participated in this year's budgetary process to include our Mutual Ministry Committee for their input on pay and benefits, our Financial Secretary, Heather Wintergerst, for her work in producing records and financial analysis, and all of the folks from our congregation that participated in the process. We began in September and concluded the workup process on December 6th with a congregational Q&A.

The totals for the 2021 Budget follow:

- Total Expenditures = \$ 243,592.57 - Total Revenues = \$ 203,000.00 - Underfunded = \$ 40,592.57

Planning for 2021 was tricky as 2020 was so unusual. We spent more money on equipment to support our livestreaming of services than expected, but spent little on things like fellowship, community meals, Wednesday dinners and youth activities.

Defining the revenue was equally tricky. The Council so appreciates all the donations given by the congregation. Our desire is that this continues in 2021. To add to the general revenue are the other donations from folks that use the building like WW and AA, the Gerloff funds and other contributions for a variety of our projects.
