"Christ is risen," "he is risen indeed," "alleluia!" I never tire from hearing these words, but how easy it is to Forget them. Jesus told his disciples three times that he would be turned over to the authorities, be beaten and suffer a horrible death by crucifixion. They must have forgotten. They would not even believe when "Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and the other women..." told the disciples what the two men in dazzling white clothes had told them. They said, "...why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be handed over to sinners, and be crucified, and on the third day rise again. Then they remembered his words..." (Luke 24: 5-6, 10).

Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him;..." (Luke 24: 30-31). In the midst of the disciples despair, Jesus showed up.

April 11th: Special Congregational Meeting to Approve the Parking Lot Reconstruction Project

Council has been discussing the condition of the parking lot for some time. At the last Council meeting, approval was given to Dale Brady. the Steward of Property and Grounds, and his committee to proceed with getting bids. Congregational approval is also required due to the cost of the reconstruction. According to the bids received Council needs to raise about \$100,000.

The finance package for this project will include \$70,000 of church funds with the additional \$30,000 being raised by fundraising activities and projects throughout the year.


The Special Congregational Meeting will be held April 11th immediately following worship. The bylaws allow us to only discuss this one item at the meeting. So it should be a short meeting. We will also provide a Zoom meeting for those who cannot attend in person.

One fundraising idea includes buying a parking spot for \$100. Bear in mind it will not be assigned to you, nor will your name be painted on the spot. Another idea is recycling aluminum cans - think soft drinks, beer cans and other drinks, pie pans, used aluminum foil, some pet food cans and that is all I can think of. There are plastic tubs by the kitchen back door in which to place the aluminum items. Other fundraising ideas are being considered by Dale's team. If you have ideas, please feel free to share them with Dale or any member of the council.


