Faith Lutheran worships each Sunday at 9:30 am. In-person worship will be held at Faith Lutheran Church and also streamed online via YouTube and Facebook.



month. To help with preparing and serving the meal on Oct. 25th contact Linda Beyer at 406-207-3471 (text or call) for more information.




Sharing God's Love with Children...

That's what Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes do! You can help spread God's love by packing a shoebox at home, participating in the Faith Lutheran Packing Party, or packing a shoebox online at Samaritanspurse.org/occ (cost: \$25 & includes the items in the box and \$10 shipping cost). The Faith Packing Party is scheduled for Sunday, November 13th after the church service and is held in the Fellowship room. It will include a light



lunch along with friends and families packing boxes together. However, the Packing Line will be set up the week before for those who would like to pack a box early or with fewer people around. The cost to ship a box is \$10/box and we do ask for help with this cost. This amount includes a booklet with the story of Jesus printed in the child's own language that is given with each shoebox. Other donations of items to put in the boxes (balls, other toys, school supplies, etc.) are greatly appreciated as well. Empty Bowls is an international project founded in 1990 to fight hunger and to advocate the arts and art education. Each event is personalized and developed independently at the community level.

Once again Clay Works! In the Bitterroot Cooperative has chosen to host Bitterroot Empty Bowls with assistance provided by The Bitter Root Resource Conservation and Development Area, Inc. (RC&D) 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization.

For a \$30 donation, you will receive a simple meal of delicious soup and bread donated by local restaurants and bakeries and a handmade bowl lovingly crafted by local potters and members of Clay Works! to take home as a reminder of the many "empty bowls" in the Bitterroot Valley.

Proceeds from this event will help reduce hunger and food insecurity in the Bitterroot.
