

Dear friends and members of FLC -

The hymnist writes, "Christ is alive, and comes to bring good news to this and every age, till earth and sky and ocean ring with joy, with justice, love and peace."

One of my greatest experiences of hearing the good news of the living Jesus Christ was at Bible Camp. We are blessed by having Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp only a couple of hours from us.

"Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp (FLBC) offers a Christcentered camping experience for people of all ages. The staff is trained to help campers understand God's message of grace and to provide positive Christian role models while having an amazing experience in God's great outdoors!

Bible Study themes are lived out each day through worship, drama, singing, small group Bible study, prayer, arts & crafts, campfire, and play as campers learn about and experience God's grace. Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp is dedicated to the spiritual, physical, and emotional growth of each person."

One of the challenges FLBC is facing this year is lack of staff. They are in desperate need of camp counselors for this summer's program. The last I have heard they have about 200 registered for summer programs so far. If you know of anyone who is 18 or older and might be interested in serving in this way, please get in touch with FLBC for an application. Applications are also available through FLBC for adult volunteers.
