

My pondering for this month revolves around the Poster that stares me down as I start down the hall to my office. The Poster is for the 2024 Youth Gathering to be held in New Orleans in July. The theme is "Created to be" and is centered around Psalm 139 (Please take a moment to read this Psalm). There are five daily themes:
