

The Faith Operation Christmas Child Packing Party is scheduled for November 12<sup>th</sup> after our church service and will include a light lunch. Plus, the Packing Line will be set up a few days before for early packing. Ways you can help make the OCC Packing Party a success is to think of and maybe purchase a "WOW" item (special toy, clothing item, game, etc.) for one or more shoebox(es) or tuck away \$10 (or more) to help ship a shoebox or purchase extra small items to fill the boxes with such as bars of soap, plush toys or stuffed animals and balls. Another way is volunteer to help set up the packing line or work at the local collection center (see Linda Beyer for these ideas and more).
