Holy Closure of Shower-Mini Pantry Ministry

From 1 Peter 4:9-11, we read,

"Be hospitable to one another without complaining. Like good stewards of the manifold grace of God, serve one another with whatever gift each of you has received. Whoever speaks must do so as one speaking the very words of God; whoever serves must do so with the strength that God supplies, so that God may be glorified in all things through Jesus Christ. What a blessing it has been to serve our community by providing showers and a small food pantry for those in need. When we began this ministry, 3 years ago, we were the only place in the community offering a shower service. Since then, the Salvation Army has opened their doors offering a shower service from Monday-Friday, from 7:30 AM-2:00 PM. Because this shower service is in town and not as remote as we are out here on Lewis Lane, and there is a larger staff base, and our numbers of use has dropped significantly, we feel it is a healthy time to bring closure to these 2 ministries.

Our last day for our shower service was Thursday May 30th. We would like to thank everyone who has made donations of food, shower bags, quilts, hygiene supplies, etc. in support of these ministries.

We ask you all to pray with us as we anticipate what ministry God is leading us into next here at FLC in order to serve our community. May God continue to strengthen us as we serve "...so that God may be glorified in all things through Jesus Christ. To him belong the glory and the power forever and ever. Amen."
